I am requesting funding for Roswell's Real Time Crime Center in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Roswell Police Department, located at 39 Hill Street, Roswell, GA, 30075.

The funding would be used for technology for Roswell's Real Time Crime Center (RTCC). The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it focuses on reducing violent crime and responding efficiently to growing calls for service. The project will protect public safety responders by increasing their situational awareness before entering an on-going crime scene and allowing officers to respond swiftly in a transparent and prepared manner. The RTCC will collect real-time data from over 100 feed sources throughout the City and display it in one central location, allowing the RPD to protect residents, businesses and visitors proactively. Cameras spread throughout Roswell will allow officers to locate missing persons before they are harmed. The RTCC will allow the RPD to share live feeds and information with neighboring police departments and first responders, increasing the regional benefit of federal dollars.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes described in section 1701(b)(8) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10381(b)(8)).
